## Don't Bite Back!

When my brother and I were growing up, we had a little dog named Tip. Now Tip was a good old dog, but he was pretty irritable. In fact, he was known to snap at those who irritated him. On one occasion, however, Tip met his match. My brother apparently played too rough with him, and Tip nipped him. My brother's reaction was simple . . . he bit Tip back. Old Tip ran o yelping, with his tail between his legs. That story illustrates the philosophy of a lot of people to- ward life. It's the old "eye for an eye" mentality. The world says, "Don't take anything o of anyone." The Bible, however, holds the Christian to a higher standard. We can achieve God's standard if we will. Re- member, it is God's prerogative to avenge wrong. He has told us, "Vengeance is Mine, I will re-

pay" (Romans 12:9). Retaliation isn't an option for us; it is something God has reserved exclusively for Him- self. Refuse to harbor resentment in your heart! As long as it is there, it will fester, and you will never heal, and the urge to get even will be di cult to re- move. Realize that we cannot be forgiven unless we are willing to forgive. Jesus taught that principle in His prayer in Matthew 6 " –For if you forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. But if you do not forgive men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses" (vv. 14-15). Rest assured **that one day every wrong will be set**
